## Sparkling

**Can-Xa Brut Cava, Penedes, Spain**      \$8    \$35  
*Dry white Sparkling wine from Penedes, Spain. Perfect as an aperitif.*

## White

**Las Perdices Pinot Grigio 2013 Mendoza, Argentina**      \$9    \$38  
*Dry, light white wine, mild and very refreshing, goes well with salads, raw fish and as an aperitif.*

**Castelo de Medina Verdejo 2013 Rueda, Spain**      \$9    \$38  
*Dry white wine with aromas of tropical fruits and green grass.  
It goes well with salads, goat cheese, and ceviches.*

**Viña Cartin Albariño 2013 Rias Baixas, Spain**      \$11    \$43  
*Dry white wine with citrus and tropical fruit aromas, an ideal match for seafood in general.*

**Montes Chardonnay 2011 Curico, Chile**      \$9    \$38  
*Medium bodied dry white wine with good weight in the mid palate.  
It goes well with fish and chicken.*

**Saarstein Riesling 2012 Mosel, Germany**      \$10    \$40  
*Off Dry medium bodied white wine with great minerality.  
Stony fruit and white flowers on the nose. It goes very well with spicy food.*

## Rose

**Genio Monastrell 2014 Jumilla, Spain**      \$9    \$38  
*A great example of a dry light rose with good minerality. Smooth with a round finish.  
Easy to drink!*

## Red

**La Greña Tempranillo 2013 Rioja, Spain**      \$9    \$38  
*Medium bodied, with raspberry and red cherry aromas and a touch of vanilla.*

**Bouchaine Pinot Noir 2010 Carneros, California**      \$12    \$45  
*Light to medium bodied wine, raspberry, a touch of red fruit flavors on the nose.  
Very soft and gentle. It goes well with light meats, and fish.*

**Epifanio Tempranillo 2010 Ribera del Duero, Spain**      \$12    \$45  
*Medium to full bodied wine with huge flavor and minor bite.  
A dark red wine filled with fruit, tobacco and vanilla flavors.  
A great food wine, it will pair beautifully with pretty much every dish that is rich in flavor.*

**Montes Sauvignon/Carmenere 2012 Colchagua Valley, Chile**      \$11    \$43  
*Ruby red color, with a delicated chocolate and vanilla aroma. It has a complex body and is full to the  
palate with a soft and generous long finish.*

**Dos Minas Malbec 2013 Mendoza, Argentina**      \$10    \$40  
*There is no place in the world where Malbec does better than in Argentina.  
The wines are full, soft and juicy. It goes well with meats in general, beef in particular.*
